
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



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. **Failure to identify damage** before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation. **Ensure that all mounting hardware is** torqued to specifications prior to use.
- 3. Disconnect the power cable and ground cable from the battery.
- 4. Place the winch vertically on the working surface so that the motor is above the gearbox.
- 5. Remove the motor housing by removing the four Phillips bolts located on the Motor side of the winch. See **Figure 1** for reference.
- 6. Remove the motor by removing the two bolts holding it in place. See Figure 2 for reference.
- 7. Remove and replace the Motor O-Rings (item 1). See Figure 2 for reference.
- 8. Remove and replace the Motor O-Rings (item 2). See Figure 3 for reference.
- 9. Reinstall the motor using the bolts removed in **Step 6**. <u>Note</u>: Ensure that the Motor O-Rings are seated properly.











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- 10. Remove the mount plate by removing the 4 flathead bolts holding it in place. See **Figure 4** for reference.
- 11. Place the winch vertically on the working surface so that the motor end of the winch is above the gearbox.
- 12. Remove the bolts holding the tie bar and plastic cover in place. See **Figure 5** for reference.
- 13. Remove the motor end drum support and place the motor end of the winch vertically on the working surface so that the brake is on top. See **Figures 5 and 6** for reference.
- 14. Remove and replace the Drum Bearing (item 3), and Drum Gasket (item 4) on the motor end of the winch. See Figure 6 for reference. Note: It is recommended that a light coat of grease is applied to the drum bearing and gasket. Make sure that both the drum bearing and gasket are seated completely in their respective locations.
- 15. Remove and replace the brake (item 5). See Figure 6 for reference.
- 16. Remove the tie bars, plastic cover, and drum from the gearbox end of the winch.
- 17. Remove and replace the Drum Bearing (**item 3**), and Drum Gasket (**item 4**) on the gearbox end of the winch. See **Figure 7** for reference.












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- 18. Rotate the drive shaft and ensure that it is properly seated.
- 19. Reassemble the winch in the reverse order in which it was taken apart.
- 20. Remove the gearbox cover by removing the 7 socket head bolts holding it in place. See Figure 8 for reference.
- 21. Remove and replace the Gearbox Cover O-Ring (item 6). See Figure 9 for reference.
- 22. Reinstall the gearbox cover using the hardware removed in **Step 20**.
- 23. Remove the clutch clip by removing the flathead bolt holding it in place. See **Figure 10** for reference.
- 24. Remove the clutch base from the gearbox by rotating it counter-clockwise. See Figure 10 for reference.
- 25. Remove and replace the Clutch Base O-Ring (item 7). See Figure 10 for reference.
- 26. Remove the clutch pin from the clutch base by removing the roll pin holding it in place. See Figure 10 for reference.
- 27. Remove and replace the Clutch Pin O-Ring (item 8). See Figure 10 for reference.
- 28. Reinstall the clutch components in the revers order that they were taken apart.
